Lave men ou avèk savon ak dlo pwòp anvan ou prepare manje, anvan ou manje, epitou anvan ou bay pitit ou manje. Fè tout moun nan fanmi ou an, granmoun tankou timoun, lave men yo avèk savon ak dlo pwòp.

You can help protect yourself and your family from getting cholera by washing your hands with soap and water. Wash your hands with soap and safe water after you use the toilet, after cleaning your child's bottom, after taking care of someone ill with diarrhea. Wash your hands with soap and safe water before preparing food, before eating food, and before feeding your children. Make sure all your family members, including your children, wash their hands with soap and safe water.
